Are you interested in a life-changing experience where everyone is enriched through their contact with new friends? Welcome to the Friends4Good family.

Greetings to all our *positively AFRICA* supporters! While *positively AFRICA* has closed its doors, the legacy lives on. We'd like to wish you the very best as we enter this new decade and share with you some very exciting news.

For many years, *positively AFRICA* worked alongside Soweto Junior Education Centre, a school for 150 children in grades 1 and 2. Your support enabled the school to maintain a nutrition program and helped purchase a piece of land for an income-generating project. The old school was no longer suitable and the new school is only partially built. Before closing, *positively AFRICA* partnered with Calgary-based Enterprise4Good to ensure completion of the construction. Their Friends4Good projects around the world have assisted vulnerable groups to develop self-sustaining business ventures.

Helping with the construction of this primary school and teachers' dormitory in Kibera, Kenya, (near Nairobi) is the opportunity of a

lifetime to change the lives of 150 young students, their teachers and the broader community. The average income of families living in the neighborhood is less than \$2/day. Education is the best way to ensure a better future.

You don't need any construction experience. Groups of 10 or more volunteers will travel to Kibera and work alongside local volunteers for a 2-week period. As long as you are medically fit you are welcome to join the team. There is a 1½ day break from the construction project when you may choose to go with the group to a game reserve or explore Nairobi.

Costs are estimated to be between \$3,500 and 4,000 CAD which includes your flight, hotel and meals. Great news! This amount is tax deductible!

Not included in these estimates are the costs of any required vaccines, a travel visa, the visit to a game reserve or incidentals.

All travel arrangements will be made by Enterprise4Good. The first trip is being planned for Spring/Summer 2020, with dates determined by volunteer availability. More trips will be planned until the work is completed.
